## **Programme Learning Outcomes**

- evaluate the overall financial system and be able to conduct analyses on expected trends in interest and exchange rates, formulate portfolio analyses and evaluations of financing decision;
- continue their studies in the second cycle degree programs, Master of Science and Professional Masters;

- interpret and assess the role of financial institutions and their behavior within the economic system;
- describe and explain concepts relating to risk management in banking sector;
